San Francisco-based artist ANNE DEVINE originates site-specific distance walking performances and public walks. She holds a BFA in Visual Art (Photography, Film & Video) from Mason Gross School of the Arts, Rutgers University and an MFA in Fine Arts (Social Practice) from California College of the Arts.
