



Foster Spragge is a painter. While searching for a venue in the City of London she criss-crossed the Square Mile in a deliberate way recording her route by making pencil marks on a large piece of paper. This act began a body of "Walking Drawings" that has led her to other cities and on pilgrimage walks. Walking Drawings represent the process of walking. The interview by Andrew Stuck was recorded in July 2012 at Foster's south London studio.
