On a hot summer's day at a walking conference in Girona, Catalunya, Andrew Stuck is accompanying self-styled photo troubadour, **Jez Hastings** on a short stroll. Jez has been known to walk to similar conferences, including a walk through Italy, Albania and Macedonia to reach a gathering in Prespas - walking long distances is in his blood.
